Thanks to Ben and Mary for the great time.

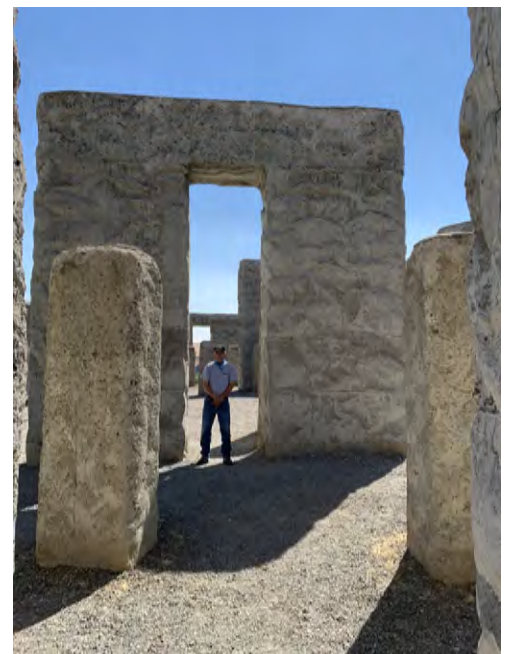

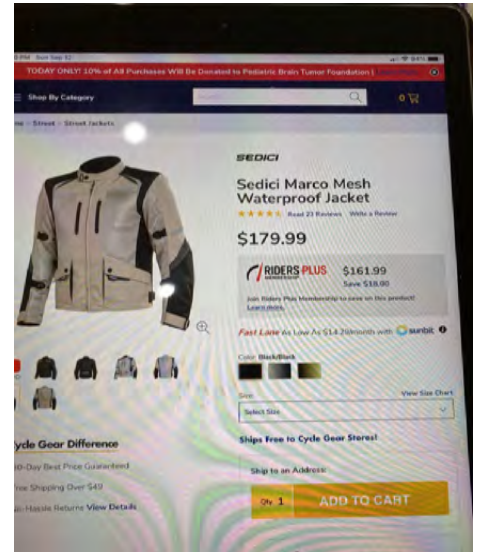

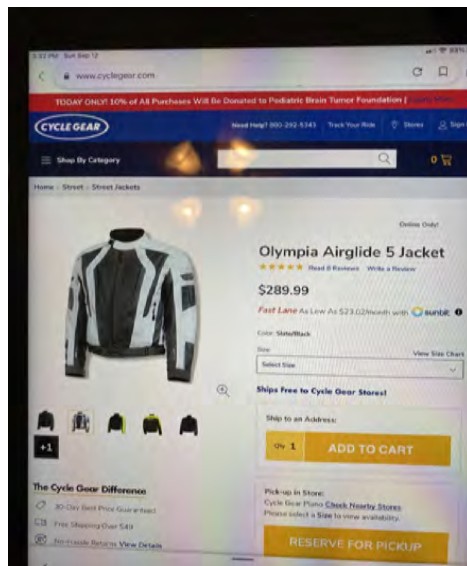
