Cowboy Caviar

- 1 green bell pepper, diced
- 1 bunch green onions, chopped
- 2 jalapenos, seeded and finely chopped
- 3 serrano chilies, seeded and finely chopped
- 1 bunch cilantro, chopped
- 5 avocados, diced
- 4 roma tomatoes, diced
- 2 15oz cans black eyed peas, drained
- 3 15 oz cans corn, drained
- 1 16oz bottle of Wish Bone Italian dressing
(Must be Wish Bone brand)
